

2017 Sponsorship Highlights

The child sponsorship program allows donors to have a personal relationship with a child in one of Orphan Outreach's ministry programs.

The sponsorship program is one of the most important ways an individual can make a lifelong difference to a child. Sponsors provided gifts of financial and prayer support to help transform the life of that child.

890 children are sponsored throughout Guatemala, Honduras, India, Kenya, Latvia, Nepal, Russia and Ukraine by donors providing at least \$36 a month.



JOSEPH'S DreamCoat





Joseph's DreamCoat (JDC) is a ministry of Orphan Outreach that provides financial support to families desiring to adopt.

JDC provides grants to families who are committed and faithful Christ-followers. JDC has a special emphasis on providing grants for pastors and ministry leaders who may long for adoption but find the costs to be prohibitive.

In 2017, 25 families received adoption grants through Joseph's DreamCoat financial assistance program.

2017 Women for Orphans Worldwide (WOW)

WOW is the auxiliary of Orphan Outreach and the founding Dallas chapter is committed to supporting Orphan Outreach's work in Guatemala.

In 2017, the WOW Dallas December luncheon and other fundraising activities raised more than \$180,000 to support orphans and vulnerable children in Guatemala. WOW chapters in Atlanta, East Texas, and Houston also collected humanitarian aid and worked to raise awareness for supporting orphans in need.







2018 Children's Hope Dinner





The 5th annual dinner featured keynote speaker Leigh Anne Tuohy, who emphasized the difference a single decision can make for orphaned and vulnerable children.

Jimmy Westcott was honored with the 2018 Orphan Outreach Children's Hope Award for her extraordinary vision in launching this very event. After witnessing firsthand the life-changing work of Orphan Outreach, Jimmy was inspired to create an annual event to raise funds and awareness for Orphan Outreach. It was decided that the event would be the perfect platform to recognize leaders who are committed to helping vulnerable children with the Children's Hope Award.

In addition, Judy Allen, founder of The Learning Tree School and longtime Orphan Outreach volunteer, was honored with the Paula Hayes Service Award. The event sold out with more than 600 attendees and raised more than \$290,000 net.
